Assignment Title: **Technical Consulting in Curriculum Development - Institutional Reinforcement for Curriculum Review of Secondary Education (Cabo Verde)**

1. The Government of Cabo Verde has received from the International Development Association – IDA / World Bank (hereafter named “World Bank”), the Credit ref. 70780 to fund the Cabo Verde Human Capital Project aims to assist the Ministry of Education in the management and coordination of the implementation of the National Plan for Teacher Training - Horizon 2020/30, and intends to apply part of the amount of said credit for: **Technical Consulting in Curriculum Development - Institutional Reinforcement for Curriculum Review of Secondary Education (Cabo Verde)**.
2. The Consulting Services (“the Services”) aims to strengthen the local technical team overseeing the revision of the secondary education curriculum. This includes the following:  
(i) Ensure specialized technical support to the National Directorate of Education (DNE) in the revision of the secondary education curriculum with a view to integrating subject-specific conceptual and procedural skills and knowledge and building learning outcomes for students, the acquisition of knowledge and its application to concrete situations; (ii) Participate in the technical implementation of the curriculum review activities for secondary education; (iii) Follow-up on tasks of the different technical teams and contracted specialists in the area of curriculum review for secondary education, contributing to the construction and deepening of learning in each subject or subject area of secondary education; (iv) Ensure the technical and programmatic monitoring of the activities of the four components to be developed as part of the curriculum review for secondary education.

The services are to be provided by a specialized skilled and expert professional, working under the direct supervision of the National Directorate for Education (DNE). The consultant will be based in Cabo Verde and work full-time. The duration of the assignment will be 12 months from the start date, renewable on the basis of positive evaluation of performance and availability of resources.

3. The detailed Terms of Reference (ToR) for the assignment shall be requested by email address given below, from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. (local time), during the working day.



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4. The UGPE now invites eligible **individual consultants** (“Consultant”) to indicate their interest in providing this service. Interested individual consultants must provide documentation/information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services: Letter of Interest duly signed and updated Curriculum vitae indicating namely, description of similar assignments, experience, and contact references in similar service is required. (Relevant material must not exceed 30 pages overall).
5. The Individual Consultant shall have the following qualifications:
  - i. Minimum Master’s degree in Educational Sciences, preferably with specialization in curriculum development or linked to education and related areas;
  - ii. Expertise in the area of Curriculum Development with between 5 to 10 years of experience in this area;
  - iii. Experience in carrying out similar work in other countries; Specialized knowledge in the area of Curriculum and Curriculum Development;

**a) Other required skills and competencies include:**

  - iv. Proven proficiency (oral and written) in Portuguese language (mandatory requirement);
  - v. Experience in coordinating large teams;
  - vi. Immediate availability to work full time or most of the time in Cabo Verde.
